If your power goes out:

1. Check your fuses or circuit breakers. This is important because if CVEC responds to an outage you could be charged a service call.
2. If all the lights are off, call your neighbors to determine whether or not they have power on the power line. This will help your cooperative get quickly to the source of the outage.
3. Note sparks, a loud noise, or trees and limbs on the power lines.
4. Please reference your Location Number when calling your cooperative.

CVEC Moves Into Temporary Headquarters During Building Project

Community Solar Project

Chippewa Valley Electric Cooperative is pursuing the idea of construction of a solar generation project. This project, based upon member interest, would be a solar community garden located at a site yet to be determined.

Interested members would have the opportunity to purchase single or multiple units, and receive credit equal to their share of the garden's electrical output applied to their electric bill. Any residential or seasonal member, regardless of whether the member is a homeowner or renter, could be a potential share owner in a community solar project. Again, this project is still very early in the planning stages, with more details to follow in the coming months.
