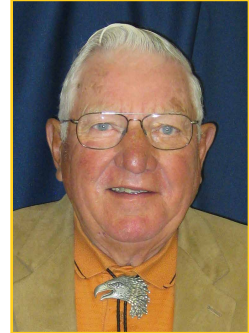
Director Candidates
