## District 3

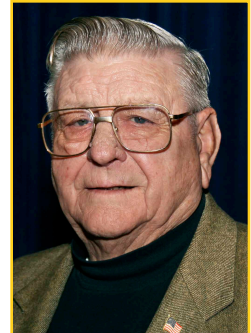
### Clyde Shipman
